Who's Who & What Do They Do?



Provides alternate hospital-to-hospital communications capabilities when primary systems (phone, internet, radio) become degraded or over-loaded.

Equipment: <u>Hospital-owned</u> but Radio Amateur-maintained and operated.

Funding Source: Hospital or by grant.



Radio Amateur volunteers who have voluntarily registered their qualifications with local ARES leadership, for communications duty in the public service when disaster strikes.

Equipment: <u>Radio Amateur-owned</u> and operated.

Funding Source: Radio Amateurs out-of-pocket

Provide realistic experience for Radio Amateurs in a support role






